




# Lodi Launching Digital OPRA Form November 5, 2018

Here's how it works: starting on November 5th, those in search of government data can access a GovPilot digital OPRA form through Lodi's official website. The form can be completed at any time of day, from any device—desktop, laptop, or tablet.

Hit "Submit" and your request for information is automatically routed to the appropriate Lodi official for swift and efficient processing. Email alerts update you at key points.

Lodi's automated OPRA workflow offers full transparency. No printing, scanning, or calling required.

## Open Public Records Act (OPRA)

The New Jersey Public Records Act (OPRA) gives New Jersey citizens greater access to public inspection and duplication of disclosable government records through the filing of an OPRA request. It is important to know that OPRA does not cover the judicial branch or municipal court, as they are regulated by other statutes.
