SUMMONSES WILL BE ISSUED TO ANYONE PUTTING SNOW OR LEAVES IN THE ROADWAY

Magazines, Cardboard and Newspaper: Includes glossy junk mail and brown paper bags. **CARDBOARD MUST BE FLAT AND TIED.**

Glass and Plastic: All glass and plastic bottles must be recycled and placed in rigid containers, **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IN PLASTIC BAGS.** Plastic items such as flower pots and garbage pails are not recyclable. Please call the DPW at (973) 365-4068 for directions on how to dispose of these items.

Grass, Leaves and Yard Waste: Will be picked up on Wednesdays with recycling from the April 6, 2016 to December 28, 2016. Grass can be mixed with yard waste and tree trimmings and placed in rigid containers, or brown leaf bags. **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IN PLASTIC BAGS.** Tree branches are to be bundled and tied not exceeding three (3) feet in length and four (4) inches in diameter.

Household Batteries: Rechargeable and button cell batteries may be dropped off at the DPW Recycling Center on SATURDAYS **ONLY** between 8:00am and 12:00pm. Alkaline batteries may be put in the regular garbage. For all other batteries visit BCUA.ORG or call (201) 641-2552 for disposal information.

The following items are NOT recyclable. You must contact the DPW at (973) 365-4068 for disposal instructions.

- **Metal and White Goods:** Including but not limited to refrigerators (doors removed), washing machines, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, window A/C units and hot water heaters. **Before a hot water heater can be picked up, you must obtain a plumbing permit from the Lodi Inspection Dept., Room 204 or (973) 859-7410.**
- **Tires:** Will **ONLY** be accepted at the DPW Recycling Center on Saturday, April 2, 2016 and Saturday, October 1, 2016, between 8:00am and 12:00pm **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP WITH THE REGULAR GARBAGE.** Visit BCUA.ORG or call (201) 641-2552 for County Drop-off dates and locations.
- **Electronics:** Including but not limited to TV's, Computers, Printers, can be dropped off at the DPW Recycling Center on Saturdays between 8:00am and 12:00pm. **THESE ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP CURBSIDE.** Visit BCUA.ORG or call (201) 641-2552 for County Drop-off dates and locations.

LEAF BAGS will be distributed from October 5, 2016 to December 7, 2016, free of charge at **Borough Hall, Room 103**, between 8:30am and 4:00pm, Monday through Friday or at the **DPW Recycling Center**, Saturdays between 8:00am and 12:00pm ONLY. (Limit 10 per family).

CHRISTMAS TREES will only be picked up on **the first two (2) Wednesdays** in January. No trees will be picked up after January 13, 2016.
